"Erin's Law" Mandates Sexual Abuse Awareness Programs in All Illinois Schools
On January 24, 2013, Gov. Pat Quinn signed a new law, Erin's Law, into effect for all Illinois schools.

Erin's Law requires schools to provide age appropriate sexual abuse prevention education for all students, Pre-Kindergarten - 12, on an annual basis. The law also requires educators to take part in training classes that cover sexual abuse and how to recognize warning signs.

We have been presenting Erin's Law since 2014.
